FILMING ON DEVELOPMENT TRUST PROPERTY

Holy Island of Lindisfarne Community Development Trust is a registered charity that seeks to improve the sustainability of our island community. The Trust owns approximately 10 hectares of land on the island, stretching from the harbour around to St. Cuthbert's Island.

The Trust also owns a number of properties on the island including Lindisfarne Heritage Centre, Lindisfarne Gospel Gardens, Window on Wild Lindisfarne, Osborne's Fort, The Old Lifeboat House and Coastguard Lookout Tower.

We receive a large number of enquiries about filming on Holy Island, from commercial crews and television teams, students, fashion shoots and others. Not only to film on Trust property, but also general enquiries about filming elsewhere on Holy Island.

Whilst keen to encourage people to explore and record Holy Island on film, the Trust does not have the resources to manage these requests all the time. No two shoots are the same and, therefore, the Trustees have agreed a policy of charging, where appropriate, for help and advice.

Organisations or individuals should contact the Trust in the first instance explaining the nature of their proposal and whether it is a commercial venture or otherwise. A form is available on our website to facilitate this. Where possible educational or research projects should explain how their work will be shared with the local community on completion.

Commercial organisations should explain the nature of their work and outline the resources required. A basic hourly rate for filming on Trust land has been agreed at £150/hour. There is a non-refundable deposit of £100 for each booking to cover administration costs.

Please remember that all income generated from filming is re-invested back into the Trust's projects. We would respectfully request that educational or other activities that are not profit making should consider making a donation to support our work and the island community and to enable the Trust to continue to support similar ventures in the future.
